

WFM software must-haves

Al-based forecasting Software that uses artificial intelligence to generate forecasts is becoming the industry standard. Even better if it is super-accurate, can forecast down to interval level for many months ahead and requires almost no setup.
Omni-channel planning Your customers can now choose how to contact you: by phone, email, web chat, social media, or support ticket. You need a WFM application that lets you easily and efficiently forecast and schedule for all channels.
Easy-to-use multi-skill scheduling Got a multi-skilled workforce and skills-based routing? You need a WFM application that lets you quickly build schedules that unlock all the 'pooling efficiencies' without huge setup effort every time you change your routing.

	Comprehensive real-time management You need real-time adherence monitoring that you can configure your way. And real-time dashboards that reveal deviations between plan and actual so you can react quickly and effectively when things start to go wrong.
	Agent engagement via smartphone Agents expect to have a say in the planning process. They expect to have self-service options, 24/7. And they expect it all on their smartphones: calendar integration and managing time-off, shift swaps, shift bidding, and more.
	Local expert support Ask vendors about the people that will be supporting you. Where are they based? How much first-hand experience do they have? Training, onboarding, consulting, and support are as important as software. Ask about documentation, too.
	Flexible, affordable, scalable Look for vendors with monthly pay-per-use billing. WFM software can't be one-size-fits-all, so look for products with multiple price/functionality plans. They can grow with you, and you won't need a disruptive migration project later on.
	No technology dead-ends Ask vendors to confirm that their product runs in any browser on any device - PC, Mac, tablet, smartphone. Don't be limited to running WFM using only browsers that support outdated technology like Java.
